With the establishment of Innovation Hub Kyoto, new facilities expand this tradition to additionally support medical and diagnostic devices.

Researchers and start-ups who aim to develop drugs or devices have a hub for connecting to large companies and investors.

INCUBATION CORE-LAB

The Incubation Core-Lab is a base for researchers aiming to start businesses. The core lab, based on an approach that is rare in Japan, provides all facilities necessary for performing general biomedical experiments. By using this lab, researchers aiming to spin start-ups out of Kyoto University can start their preparation independently. Even with limited finance, they can move into the lab and initiate the process to gather key information. Researchers who aim to establish start-ups are urged to make maximal use of this lab.
